Recipe of the month:

### Sensation Salad Dressing

1 C olive oil

2 T fresh lemon juice

3 cloves garlic, minced and mashed, or more to taste

2 T white vinegar

salt and black pepper to taste

granulated garlic to taste

2 T chopped fresh parsley

1 C grated Romano cheese

In a 1-quart jar with lid, blend together oil, cheese, lemon juice, garlic, and white vinegar. Season to taste using salt, pepper and granulated garlic. Cover with lid and shake extremely well. Store salad dressing in the refrigerator. Traditionally served over ice-cold iceberg lettuce, but you may use it on any salad. Perfect for a wedge salad. Add anchovies if you love them.
