SPEAKER SERIES: From the podium.....

January 5, 2015 — 7:00 pm — Fishers of Men Lutheran Church

The Museum of the Islands will present a program featuring D.L. Havlin, author and Pine Island resident, on Monday, January 5, 2015, 7:00 p.m. at the Fishers of Men Lutheran Church, 10360 Stringfellow Road, St. James City.

Mr. Havlin will present a power-point program on his historical novel *Blue Water, Red Blood*. The book retells the story of two Americans, Holland Smith and Don Roebling, who were instrumental in winning the World War II island battles in the Pacific. His presentation will concentrate on the portion recounting Florida's contribution to this effort. Featuring far more history than fiction, the book's roots are in Florida's 1928 killer hurricane on Okeechobee. Roebling developed the amphibious tractor as a hurricane rescue vehicle and adapted it to make Smith's military plans a reality. The machine was developed and manufactured in Florida and made war's most dangerous event, frontal assault against a fortified beach, possible. This is a can't-miss event for history buffs, military book readers, people interested in Florida's past, and those that wish to learn how our political system impacts life and death decisions. The author's books will be available and signed after the event.
